

Lego

Each set of Lego should have 15 pieces.

1x BLACK flat piece (this is the base and is not represented on the sheets)

4x BROWN 1x2

1x BROWN 2x2

1x BROWN 2x4

1x GREY 1x2

1x RED 1x2

1x RED 2x2

1x BLUE 2x2

1x YELLOW 2x2

2x YELLOW 2x3 (these are 3 flat pieces stuck together for lack of resources, if they ask you if this is important, it isn't)

1x GREEN 2x4

Each set of numbered sheets 1-7 is the birds-eye view of a construction using all 14 pieces. They correspond to the unnumbered sheets, which are the left side views. After constructing each one, take the front view and read off each letter.

If you label the left side views a-g on the PDF linked from this page, the corresponding top views are:

a) corresponds to 6)

b) corresponds to 1)

c) corresponds to 2)

d) corresponds to 5)

e) corresponds to 7)

f) corresponds to 3)

g) corresponds to 4)
